
Step 1:

top of the Safari Web browser:





keyboard:






If "Updated" is displayed, click on it, then click on "Name" in the pop-up menu:






Double-click on any folder that might have dot URL links to free Web-based training that you might be interested in:











Click on "Go" at the top of the  
monitor screen:



Click on "Downloads" in the pull-down menu:




A "Downloads" folder will be
