# USING "WINDOWS 11" TO CONTROL AN iPhone

- Microsoft's bundled "Phone Link" app in a "Windows 11" computer can be used to control a cell phone if you install Microsoft's free "Link to Windows" app into the cell phone.

- Microsoft's bundled "Phone Link" app in "Windows 11" can be used to control an "iPhone" if Microsoft's free "Link to Windows" app is installed in the "iPhone".

# USING "PHONE LINK" IN WINDOWS" TO CONTROL AN "iPHONE" (continued)

- From inside your Apple "iPhone", go to the "App Store" and install Microsoft's free "Link to Windows" app

# USING "PHONE LINK" IN WINDOWS" TO CONTROL AN "iPHONE" (continued)

- Then use your LEFT mouse button to click on "For iOS users" at <https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/windows/sync-across-your-devices?r=1>

# USING "PHONE LINK" IN WINDOWS" TO CONTROL AN "iPHONE" (continued)


- When you use "Phone Link" in "Windows 11" to connect to "Link to Windows" in an "iPhone", some of the screens that would otherwise be available in "Phone Link" in an Android cell phone are missing:

# USING "PHONE LINK" IN WINDOWS" TO CONTROL AN "iPHONE" (continued)

- Inside the "Desktop" of your "Windows 11" computer, there is no screen image of the iPhone
- Inside the "Phone Link" app of your "Windows 11" computer, there is no "Apps" tab, and there is no "Photos" tab.

# USING "PHONE LINK" IN WINDOWS" TO CONTROL AN "iPHONE" (continued)

- When you use "Phone Link" in "Windows 11" to connect to "Link to Windows" in an "iPhone", all you have is a "Messages" tab and a "Calls" tab:

- The computer and the cell phone DO NOT HAVE TO CONNECT TO THE SAME Wi-Fi wireless access point in the local router
