"TETHERING" AND "HOTSPOT" FOR CELL PHONES

- Four ways to tether or create a
 hotspot with a cell phone:
 - Option 1: tethering using Wi-Fi
 - Option 2: tethering using a
 - "cell phone to USB" cable
 - Option 3: tethering using Bluetooth
 - Option 4: tethering using an add on
 - wired Ethernet adapter


ADVANTAGE OF USING A Wi-Fi HOTSPOT FROM A CELL PHONE

Of the four configurations for tethering from a cell phone, only **OPTION 1: tethering using Wi-Fi** lets you connect more than one device to the Internet-providing cell phone at any given point in time.


OPTION 1 BIG STEPS ("Option 1:" = tethering using Wi-Fi)

- BIG STEP 100:
 Set up Wi-Fi "Hotspot" emanating
 from the the cell phone
- BIG STEP 200:
 Connect to the Wi-Fi "Hotspot" from inside the client device


SMALL STEP 101: Locate the "Settings" icon in the Android cell phone:




If the on-off indicator for "Mobile Hotspot" is enabled, tap on it twice to disable and then re-enabled it:







The "Network name" is the name of the "Wireless Access Point" which is also known as the


"SSID" = "service set identifier" of the Wi-Fi hotspot that will emanate from the Android cell phone.
