SUMMARY

If you do not have a third-party anti-virus/anti-malware app installed in your computer, you can use the bundled "Quick Scan" to attempt to remove malware infections from a "Windows.." computer.

BIG STEP 100 = "QUICK SCAN" IN "WINDOWS SECURITY"

- SMALL STEP 101:
Use the LEFT mouse button to click on
the "Start" button of "Windows.."

BIG STEP 100 = "QUICK SCAN" IN "WINDOWS SECURITY" (continued)

- SMALL STEP 102:
If you are running "Windows 11", use the LEFT mouse button to click on "All apps"

BIG STEP 100 = "QUICK SCAN" IN "WINDOWS SECURITY" (continued)

- SMALL STEP 103:
Scroll vertically down in the "Start Menu"
and use the LEFT mouse button to click
on "Windows Security"

BIG STEP 100 = "QUICK SCAN" IN "WINDOWS SECURITY" (continued)

- SMALL STEP 104:
Use the LEFT mouse button to click on
"Virus & threat protection"

BIG STEP 100 = "QUICK SCAN" IN "WINDOWS SECURITY" (continued)

- **SMALL STEP 105:**
Use the **LEFT** mouse button to click on "Quick scan".
If non "Quick scan" button is available, click on "Scan options"; then select "Quick scan"; then scroll vertically downward and click on "Scan now"
