


"FREE CAM"

 "Free Cam" can then export it's recordings to the .WMV format.




- The "Free Cam" window will disappear
- A dotted-line rectangle will be displayed:



 Each corner of the dotted-line rectangle has a draggable handle just inside of the corner:



 The center of each of side of the rectangle has a draggable handle just inside of it:




 The entire rectangle can be dragged at any point of the rectangle that is not near one of the above-mentioned handles.

 Adjust the dotted-line rectangle so that it surrounds the entire viewing area of the media player:




 The controls for the "Free Cam" recording process are OUTSIDE of the dotted line rectangle: If a microphone icon is displayed, click on it to put a slash through it to avoid putting extraneous sounds into the recording:






 Click on the "Red" record button of "Free Cam" to start the recording process:




 Start the media player by clicking on it's triangular "Start" button:





 Make sure that the mouse cursor is not inside the recording rectangle.

 After the video finishes playing, stop the recording process either by pressing the Esc key of the keyboard or by pressing the "Stop" button of "iSpring Free Cam":







 After you stop the recording process, the "iSpring Free Cam" window will re-appear with a thumbnail of the recorded video inside it:






 Click on "Save as Video" to export the recording to a .WMV file in C:\Users\<your Windows user name>\Documents\





















 If you have not already saved the recording, then a dialog box will ask you if you wish to save the recording. Note that "saving" the recording is not the same as "exporting" the recording:




If you click on the "Save" button,
