- "Windows App" is a "Windows App" in Windows 11 and Windows 10

- Microsoft claims that the "Windows App" app will replace the "Remote Desktop Connection" app

"Windows App" IS USELESS FOR MOST COMPUTER USERS (continued)

- A "school or business account" is created from inside a "Windows server" by a "server administrator". You probably do not have one.

"Windows App" IS USELESS FOR MOST COMPUTER USERS (continued)

- In contrast, "Remote Desktop Connection" works if you are logged into your computer with a "Microsoft account" which is what most us have.

"Remote Desktop Connection"

- For an unknown amount of time, "Remote Desktop Connection" will still be available in "Windows 11" computers:

"Remote Desktop Connection"

- "Remote Desktop Connection" in your "Windows 11 Home" or your "Windows 11 Pro" computer connects to your local network router which then connects to a "Windows 11 Pro" computer with "Remote Desktop" enabled.

USE "VNC" TO AVOID THE PROBLEMS IN THE "WINDOWS APP" APP

- After Microsoft gets rid of "Remote Desktop Connection", you can use "VNC" in a "Windows 11.." computer to remotely access and control a locally-connected "Windows 11.." computer as follows:

USE "VNC" TO AVOID THE PROBLEMS IN THE "WINDOWS APP" APP

- Use TightVNC's free "VNC Server" on the target computer
