# BASIC STRATEGY

- Do not place portable apps on the Windows "Desktop" to keep it free for the new computer user.
- Do not place portable inside the "Users" folder to keep the new computer user from modifying them
- Make a separate portable browser folder for each Web site that the

# **BASIC STRATEGY (continued)**

- Make a separate portable browser folder for each Web site that the computer user will be visiting often
- Make a DOCX file name "My Diary" on the Windows "Desktop"

# ACTUAL SETUP STEPS

- Go to [PortableApps.com](http://PortableApps.com) and download and install "Chrome Portable"
- Go to [PortableApps.com](http://PortableApps.com) and download "LibreOffice Portable"

## "WINDOWS APPS" (continued)

- "Outlook" is the free, bundled replacement for "Windows Mail and Calendar". It does not create or open PST files.
- "Outlook (classic)" is the paid version of Outlook that comes with the not-free "Microsoft Office" or the not-free "Microsoft 365". It allows you to create or open PST files.
