SUMMARY

You can increase the speed of most "Windows 11" computers.

BASIC STRATEGY

- No direct editing of the “registry”
- Make reversible changes to the "Windows.." operating system

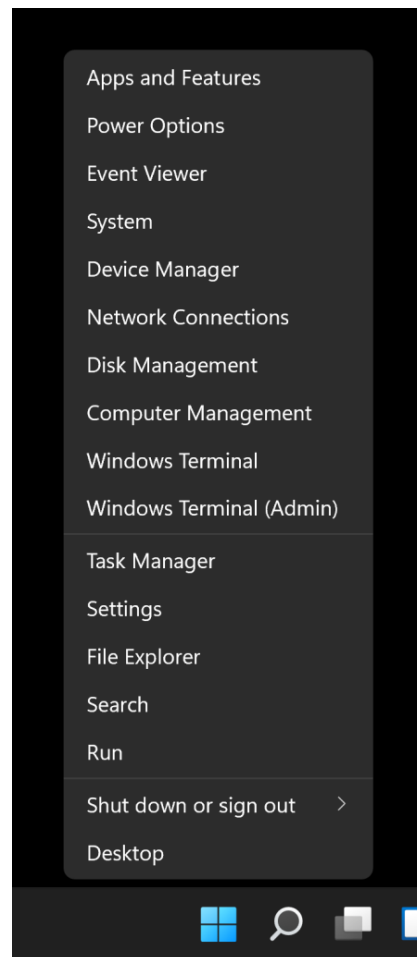
Set “Visual Effects” (continued)

press Windows key + x key)

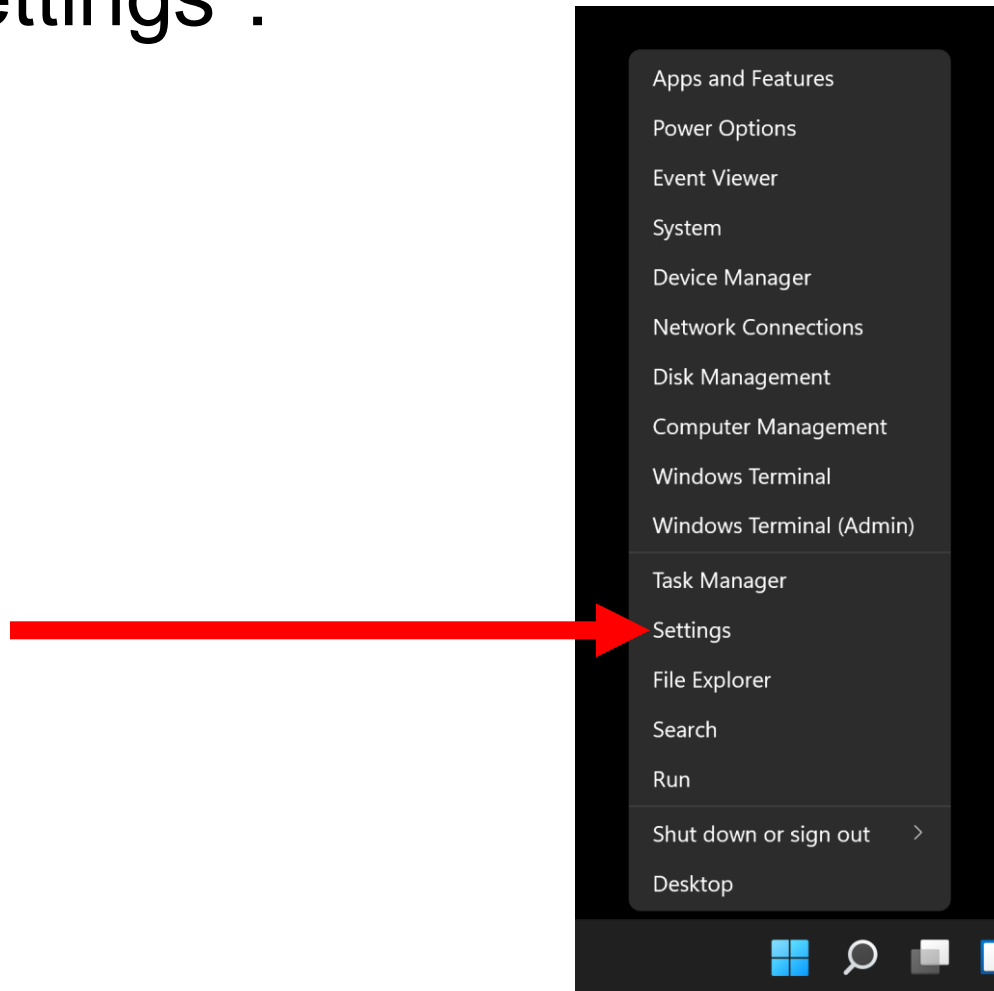
- Step 2b: A "Power User's Task Menu" will pop up and cover the Start Button:

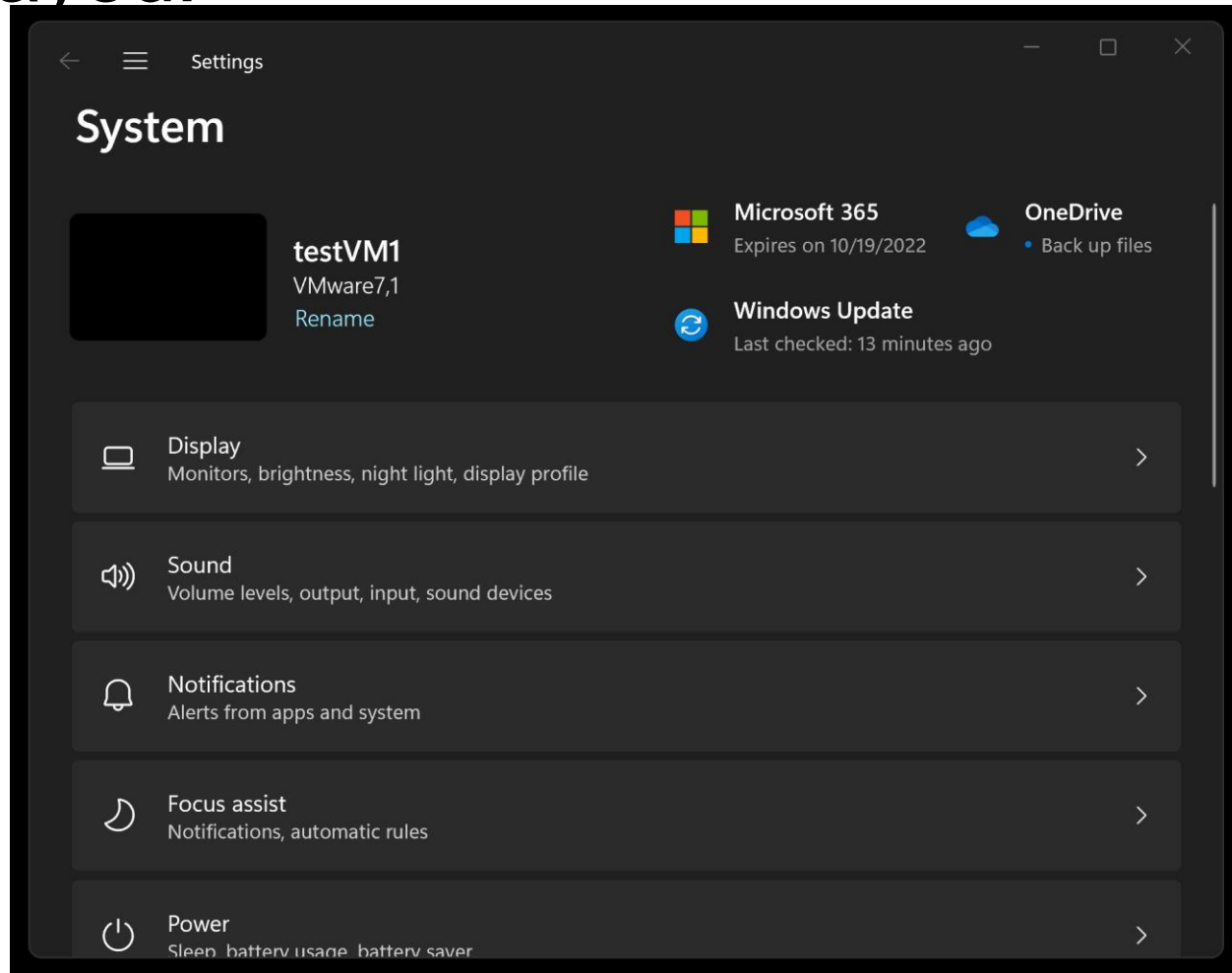
- Step 2c: Use the left mouse button to click on "Settings":

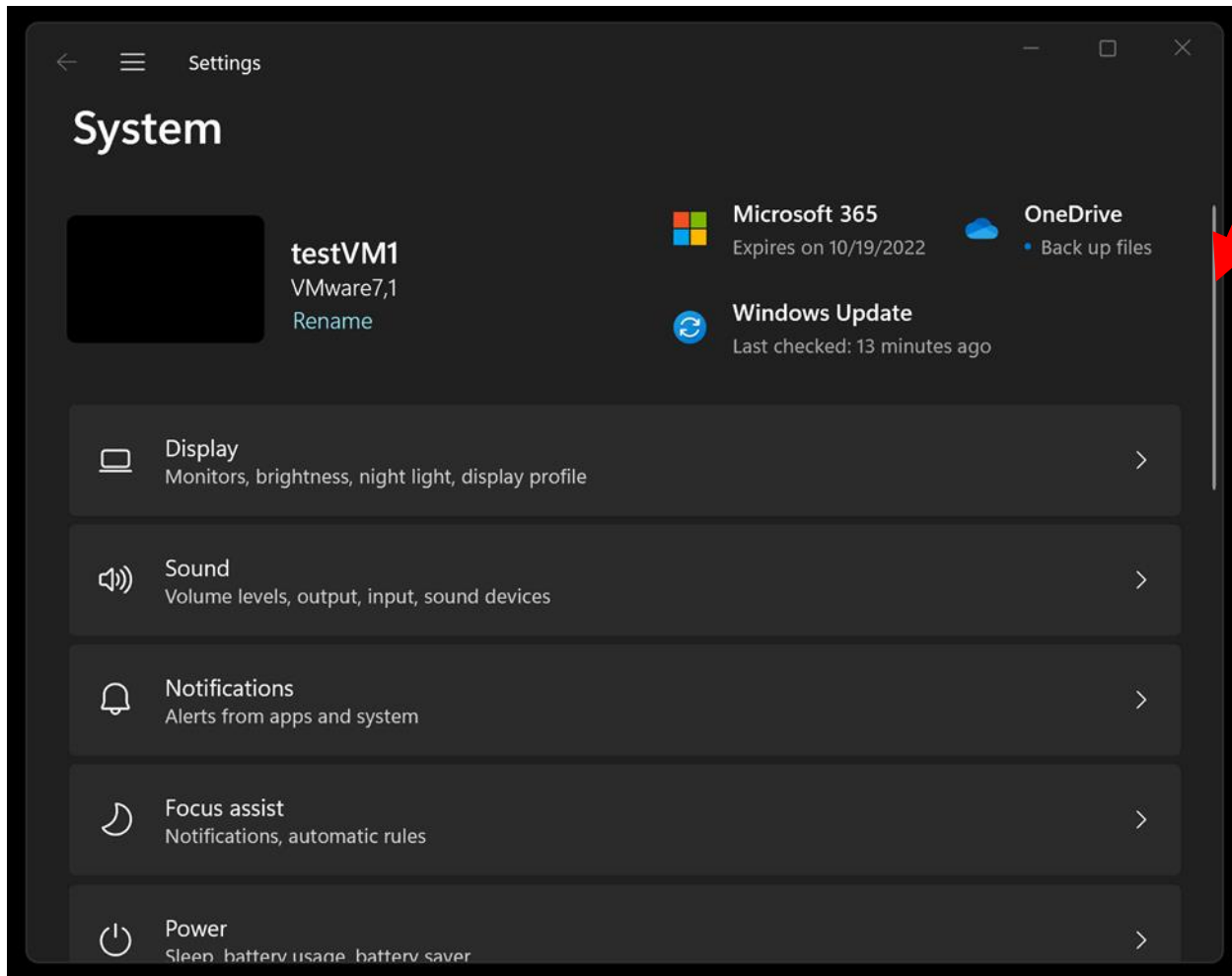
- Step 2d: A "Settings" applet window will be displayed:

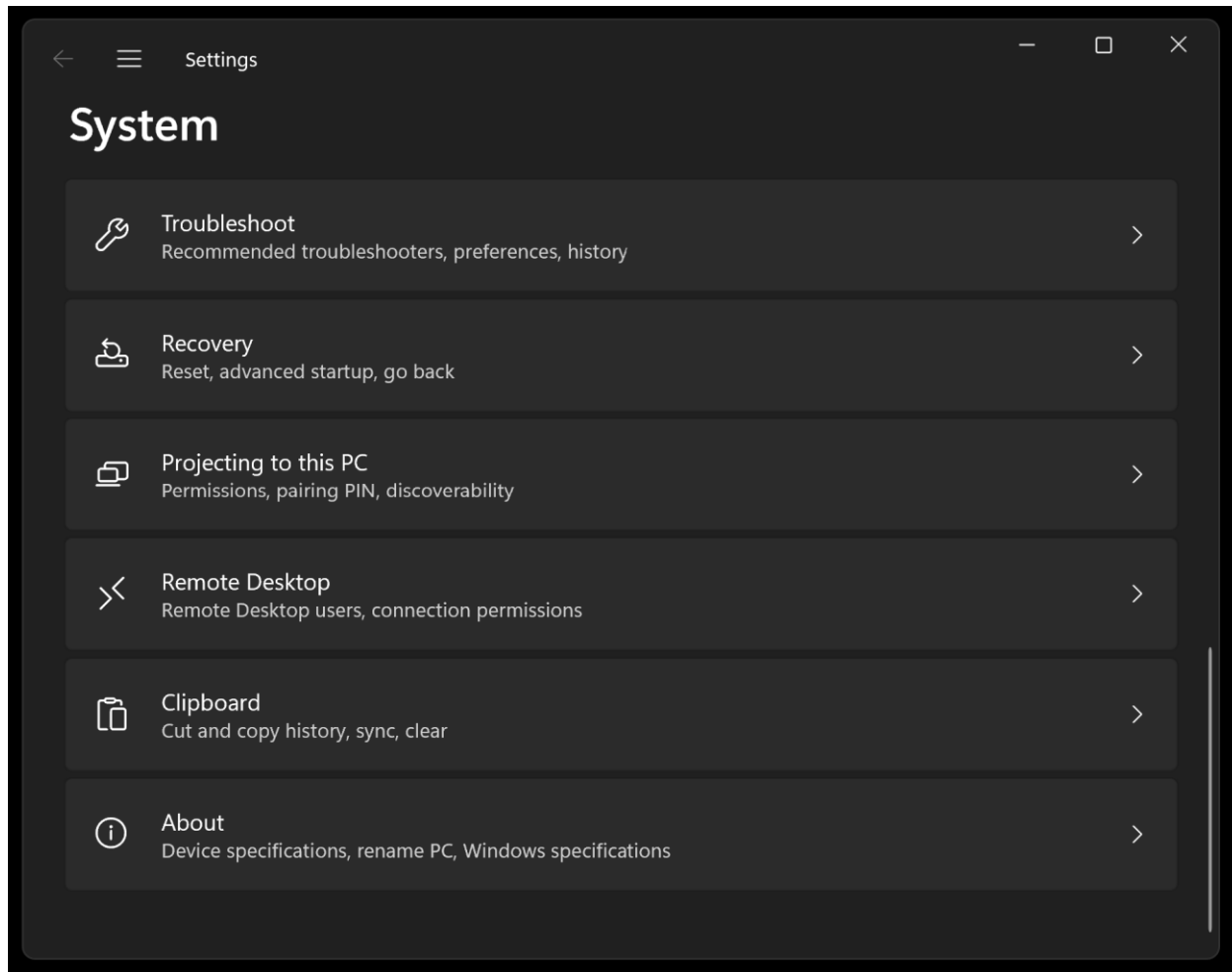
- Step 2e: Drag the vertical scroll bar downward:

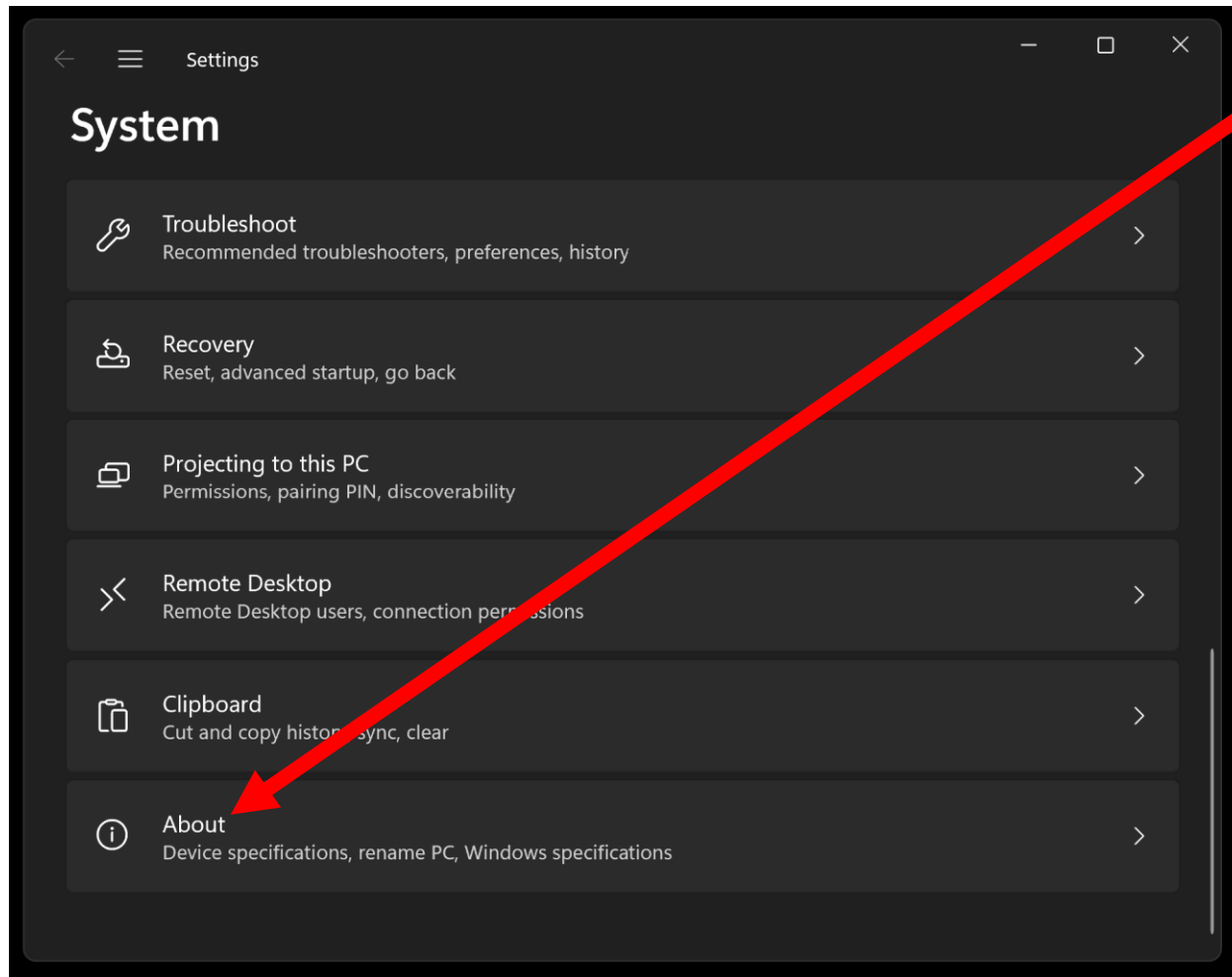

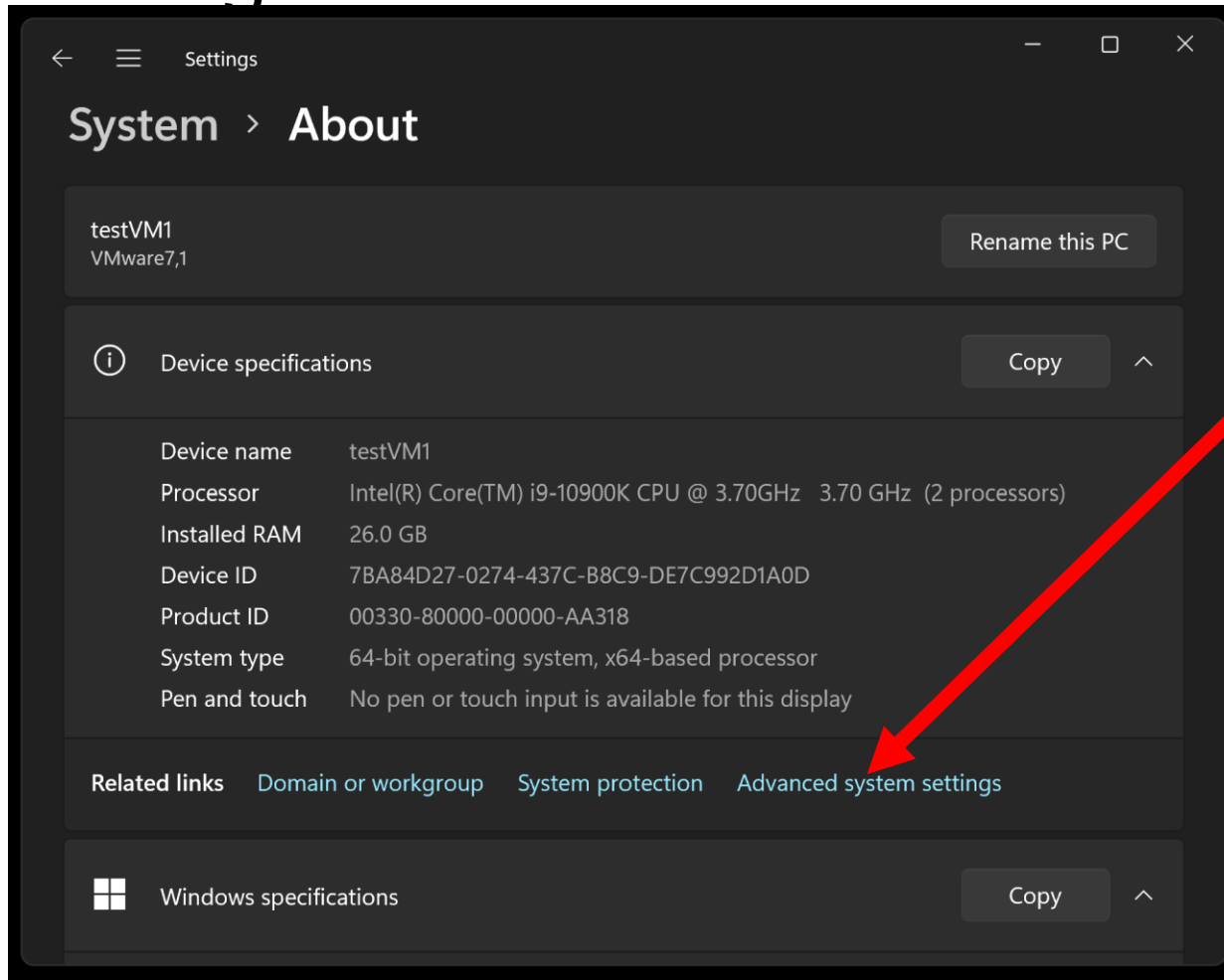

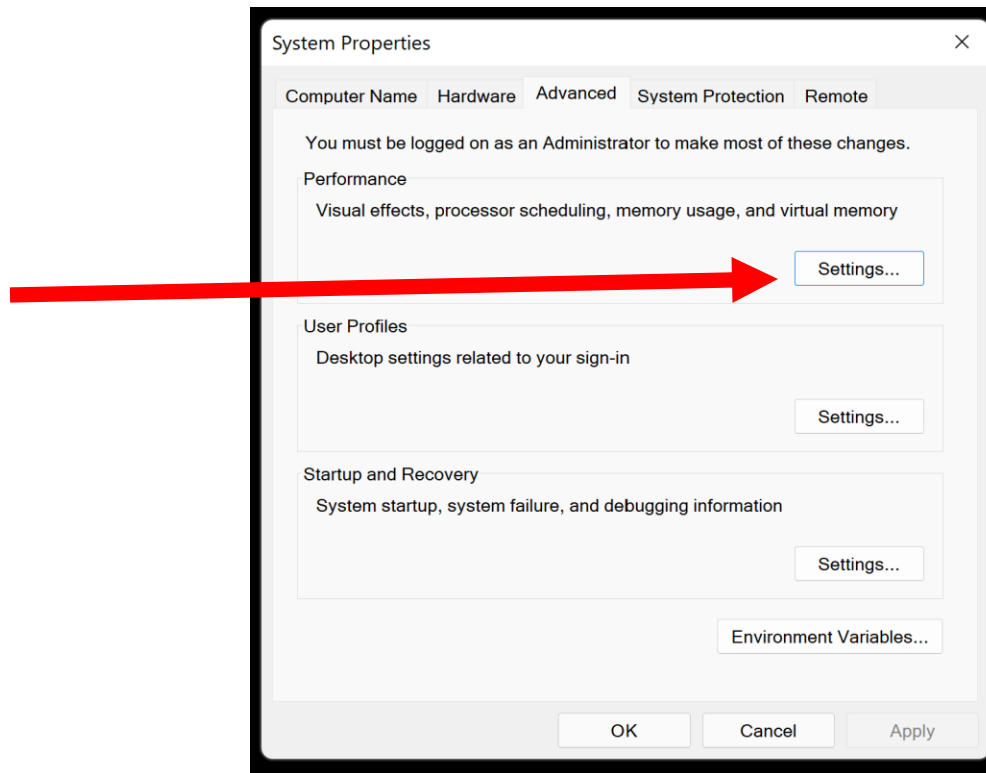
- Step 2f: Click on "Advanced System Settings":

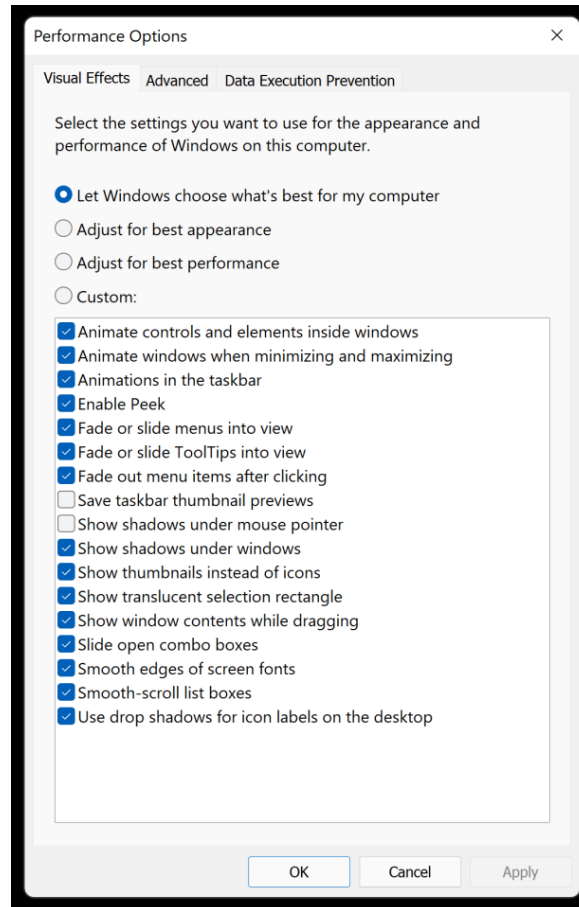
- Step 2g: Click on "Settings..." inside the "Performance" section of the "Advanced" tab:

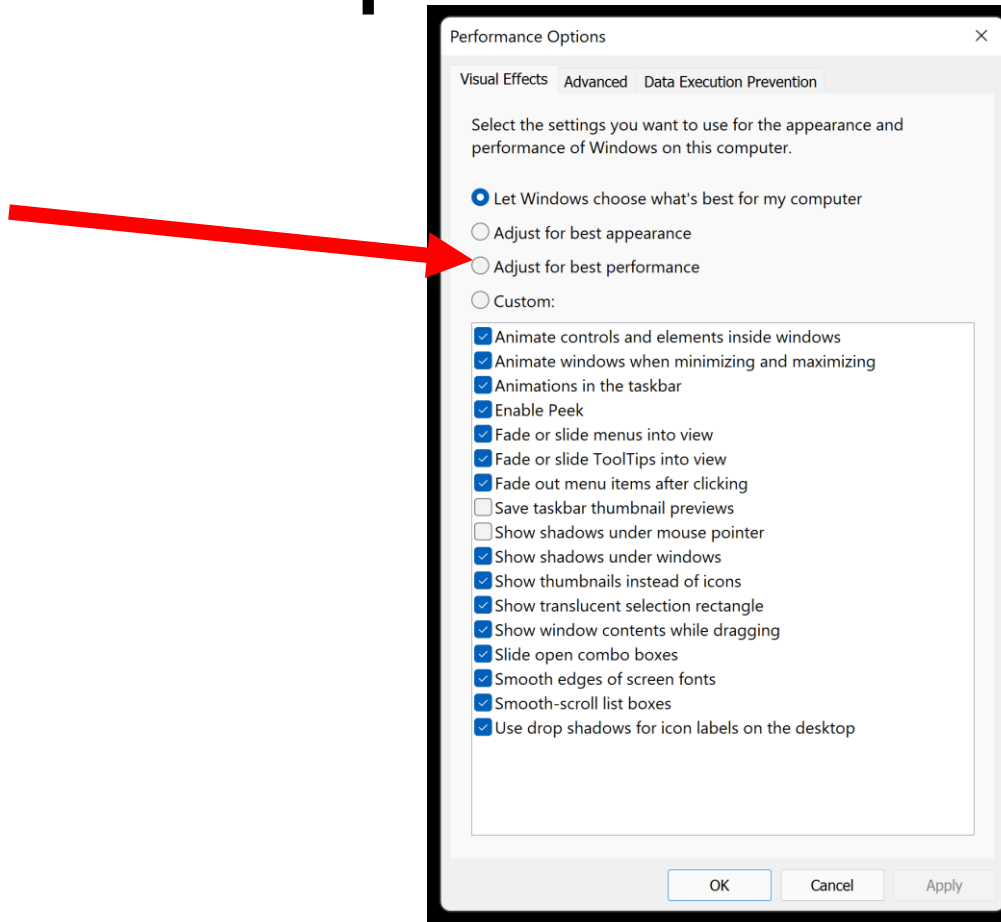
- Step 3i: A “Performance Options” box will appear:

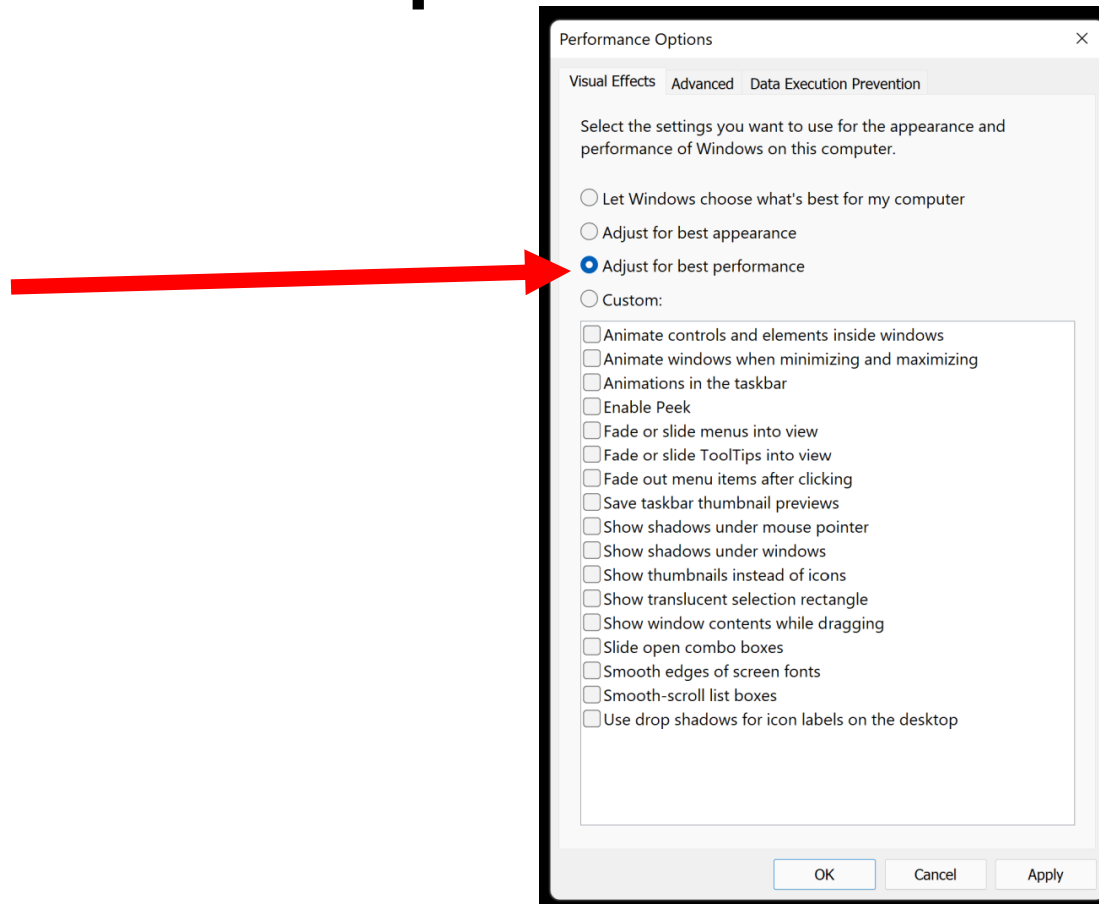
- Step 3j: Select the "Adjust for best performance" option:

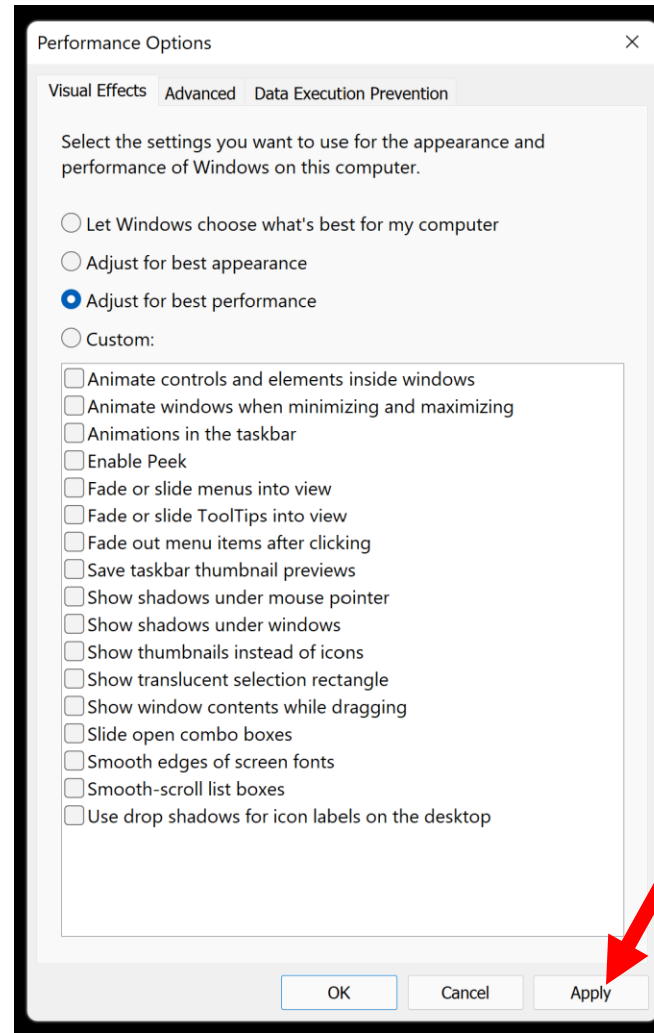
