

MOVING & COPYING & STARTING UP VIRTUAL MACHINES IN "VIRTUALBOX"

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SUMMARY

Moving and copying virtual machines in "VirtualBox" requires exporting and importing.

Start up a virtual machine in VirtualBox by using the LEFT mouse button to double-click on the *.vbox file of the virtual machine.

DEFAULT LOCATION FOR VIRUTAL MACHINES IN VMWARE WORKSTATION PRO OR PLAYER

- C:\Users\<user name>\\VirtualBox VMs\
<Name of Virtual Machine>

EXPORT THE VIRTUAL MACHINE

- Start "VirtualBox".
- Right-click on the virtual machine and click on "Export to.."
- An "Export Virtual Appliance" dialog box will be displayed

IMPORT THE VIRTUAL MACHINE

- Start "VirtualBox"
- Click on "File"
- Click on "Import Appliance..."

STARTING UP A VIRTUAL MACHINE IN "VIRTUALBOX"

- Locate the folder that contains the virtual machine.
- Use the LEFT mouse button to double-click on the *.vbox virtual motherboard file.
