

Here's a neat device. You can get a quick EKG with the Kardia Monitor.

It is manufactured by AliveCor.

It's the size of a credit card and can be carried easily in your pocket or purse.

How does it work? You just place your fingers on the sensors. Doesn't require wires, patches or gels.



It pairs with your cell phone and displays the EKG right on the screen in only 30 seconds.

It is FDA-approved to detect atrial fibrillation, bradycardia and tachycardia, among other things.

The connection if Bluetooth and WiFi is not required.

It's easy to send the results to your doctor for follow-up action if required.
